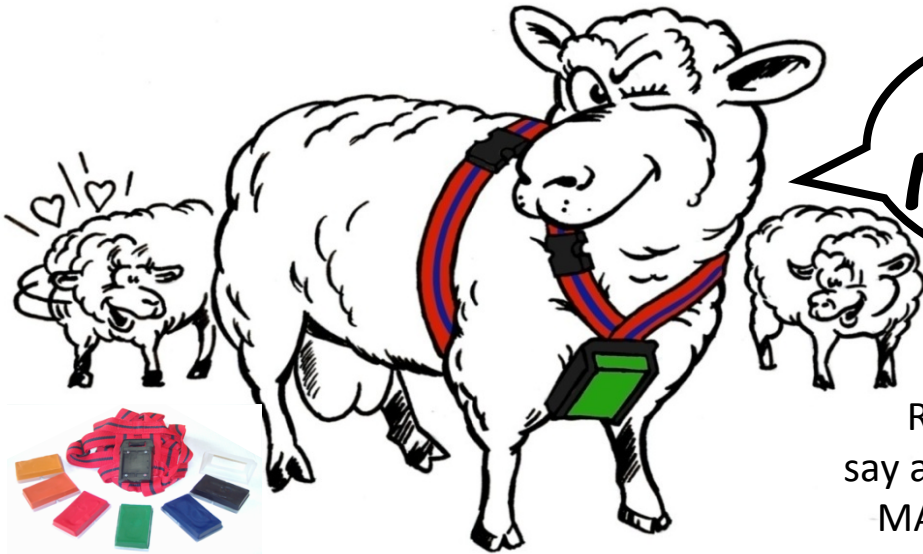

The unique formulation and lower walls on the crayon holder mean more marks per MATINGMARK Crayon than with any other.

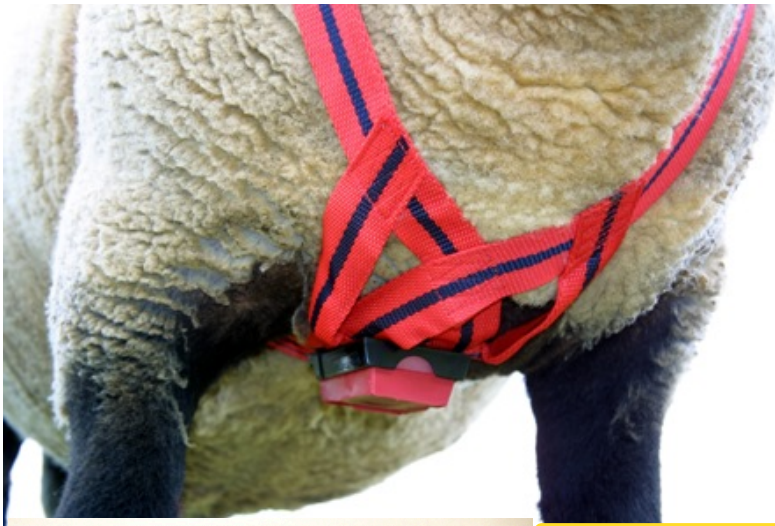
Advanced Design, Made to Last

Using Teasers prior to mating?

By attaching a **NO MATE** Harness to the MATINGMARK Harness, rams are prevented from penetrating. The same rams can then be used for teasing and mating, saving on the cost of vasectomising and feed.

A cotter pin can be found under the label of each MATINGMARK Crayon so it can be used with any old style harness.

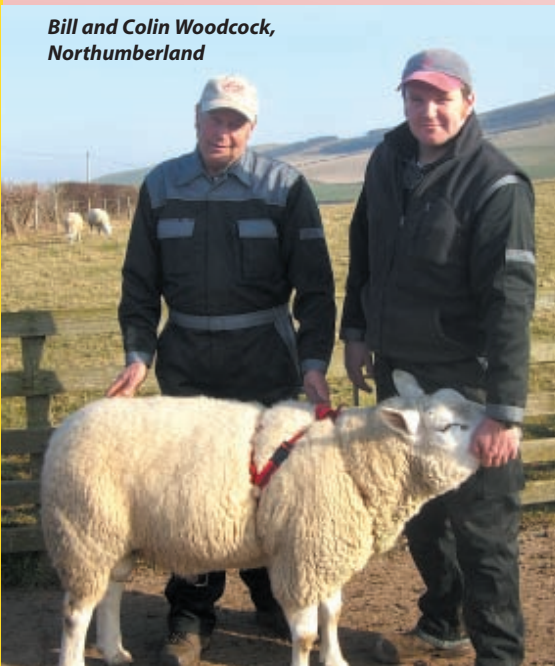

Bill Woodcock and his son Colin are fifth generation sheep farmers running 1,100 commercial ewes and 100 pedigree Texels on a 1,090 acre site near Cornhill on Tweed, Northumberland.

"Before we found MATINGMARK we had to keel the rams a couple of times a week, which took a lot of time and effort and wasn't really reliable method of seeing if the ewes had been served. The MATINGMARK design is revolutionary. Crayon replacement is particularly easy - it just clicks in and out without screwdrivers or pins. This simple crayon change system saves about 70% of the time it originally took. And the MATINGMARK crayons give a clear and reliable mark, and the crayons really last. The extra wide webbing and brisket mould is also excellent. It ensures that the harness stays in the middle of the brisket - preventing slippages which wound the ram. Owen Evans runs a sheep enterprise on the Isle of Anglesey, with 400 Welsh half-bred ewes, 50 Charollais, 20 Border Leicester and 10 Suffolk pure-bred ewes.

"It's all about the quality of materials used to make the MATINGMARK harness and crayons. The webbing keeps its shape and the construction prevents curling and it doesn't cut into the animal.

MATINGMARK is easy to fit, stays in place after days of work and is very ram-friendly. The other great advantage is the fact that it's possible to change the crayon without having to turn the ram on his back. The wide range of coloured crayon blocks is very useful too - I can cover the whole season, and the individual crayons each last a fortnight. Some other markers that I've used in the past could be plastered all over the backs of a couple of ewes in an afternoon.
